AN ORDINANCE

ADOPTING AN ALTERNATIVE TAX BUDGET FOR THE CITY OF HUBBARD, OHIO FOR THE FISCAL YEAR COMMENCING JANUARY 1, 2021, AND SUBMITTING COPIES OF SAME TO THE TRUMBULL COUNTY BUDGET COMMISSION.

WHEREAS, Ohio law requires government agencies to submit tax budgets annually to the county budget commission by July 1st.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of Hubbard, Trumbull County, Ohio:

SECTION 1: An alternative tax budget for the City of Hubbard, Ohio for the fiscal year commencing January 1, 2021, is attached hereto, incorporated as if fully rewritten herein, and marked as "EXHIBIT A".

SECTION 2: The Clerk of Council is hereby authorized and directed to forward to the Trumbull County Auditor, as Secretary of the Trumbull County Budget Commission, a certified copy of this Ordinance and all incorporated documents and Exhibits, forwith.

SECTION 3: All prior Ordinances or parts thereof in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4: All formal actions of the City Council of Hubbard, Ohio relating to the adoption of this Ordinance, and all deliberations of the City Council of Hubbard, Ohio and any of its committees leading to such action, were in meetings open to the public as required by law.
